It's one of the most frequent questions we receive at Top Notch. These answers should lead you in the right direction when faced with repairing or replacing a unit.

What is the age of my air conditioner?

Today's average lifespan for an air conditioner is 12 years give or take. Longevity will depend on proper maintenance, manufacturer and usage.

How often am I repairing and at what cost?

If your repair costs are on the rise, it usually means your air conditioner's lifespan is going down. If you've reached the 10-year mark and you are repairing once a year or more, it might be time to consider replacing. Another question to ask: Are my repairs going from simple to more complicated and expensive ones? Older units may require parts that are discontinued or are expensive to obtain. It can be much cheaper to replace than repair in the long run.

Am I sacrificing efficiency and money?

An air conditioner installed in the '90s or early 2000s probably has a SEER (Seasonal Energy Efficiency Rating) of 7 to12. These days the minimum SEER is 13. The higher the SEER, the less impact on the environment and on your pocketbook. If your A/C is blowing

lukewarm or is taking longer to cool your home, chances are you are paying higher utilities bills as a result. A new unit might be the answer to a more comfortable living environment.

A simple TIP to lower the risk of a HOUSEHOLD FIRE

Our clothes dryer is a modern convenience we can't live without but one appliance that can get taken for granted. Dryers present a serious fire hazard to thousands of homes, and with a lint buildup, all it takes is a quick spark.

According to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), there are an estimated 16,800 home fires per year involving clothes dryers or washing machines. Clothes dryers are responsible for 92% of home fires started in the laundry room. Of these fires, 32% result from a failure to clean the lint filter. A simple safety precaution is to check the filter before you flip the switch and clean after every load.

To take prevention measures a step further, check your air exhaust vent and pipe at least once a year. Restricted or obstructed vents might prevent air from releasing through the exterior exhaust flap. You might even find a pipe malfunction or crack around elbows.
